# Notice of Race

## 67<sup>th</sup> Annual Lahaina to Honolulu Race

Monday, September 6, 2010

Organizing Authority: Hawaii Yacht Club (HYC)

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be conducted according to *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*, including the 2010 updates, US Sailing Prescriptions and Hawaii Yacht Racing Association (HYRA) Prescriptions unless otherwise amended in this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS 51 and 52 are modified to allow the use of integrally designed CBTF and water ballast technology.
- 1.3. RRS 52 is modified to allow the use of winches operated using stored power.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all yachts that meet offshore requirements for ISAF Special Regulations Category 3 (no liferaft required) and are members of HYRA member clubs, and other yachts that may be invited by the organizing authorities.
- 2.2. Liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 is required.**
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and submitting it, together with the required fee and certificate of insurance (if not already on file), to the HYC office by Friday, August 27, 2010 (early registration deadline). Entries will also be accepted at the Skipper's Meeting on Sunday, September 5, 2010.
- 2.4. Yachts shall present their valid handicap certificate **and insurance certificate** with entry form if not already on file with the HYC race committee.
- 2.5. All yachts must have a valid PHRF rating or apply for one by August 21, 2010.
- 2.6. There will be no restrictions on advertising per ISAF Regulation 20.

### 3. MOORING

- 3.1. Mooring in Lahaina prior to the regatta is available on a first-come, first serve basis. The Lahaina Small Boat Harbor typically has moorings and a limited number of slips available. The Harbor Agents can be reached at 808-662-4060. LYC has several moorings available for visiting yachts. The LYC office can be reached at 808-661-0191.
- 3.2. Mooring in Waikiki after the regatta is available on a first come first serve basis. Temporary moorings may be available at the Ala Wai Harbor or at the HYC Aloha Dock. The Ala Wai Harbor Master (Kenneth Chee) can be reached at 808-973-9727.

**4. FEES**

4.1. Required fees are as follows:

4.2. Early registrations, including payment and insurance certifications, must be received at the HYC office no later than 1600 hrs Friday, August 27th.

**5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

5.1. Entry into LYC is restricted to members of LYC and their guests. Reciprocity will be granted to members of other recognized yacht clubs upon presentation of the membership card. Temporary membership cards to LYC will be available for crew members of racing yachts at no charge.

5.2. The HYC Monday Night BBQ is open to all participants in the Lahaina to Honolulu Race. **Bring your own food to cook and enjoy the evening.**

6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** will be available September 5, 2010 at the skippers' meeting, and at the Lahaina Yacht Club lower deck thereafter.

7. **COURSE** will be in the waters between Honolua Bay, Maui and the Ala Wai Boat Harbor, Oahu.

8. **SCORING** shall use the ORR handicap system and the PHRF handicap system. The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply. PHRF will be scored time-on-time.

9. **PRIZES** will be awarded at HYC on Friday, **September 10** at 1930 hrs. For each class, 1<sup>st</sup> prize will be awarded if three or more boats enter, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize will be awarded if five or more boats enter, and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize will be awarded if seven or more boats enter.
